

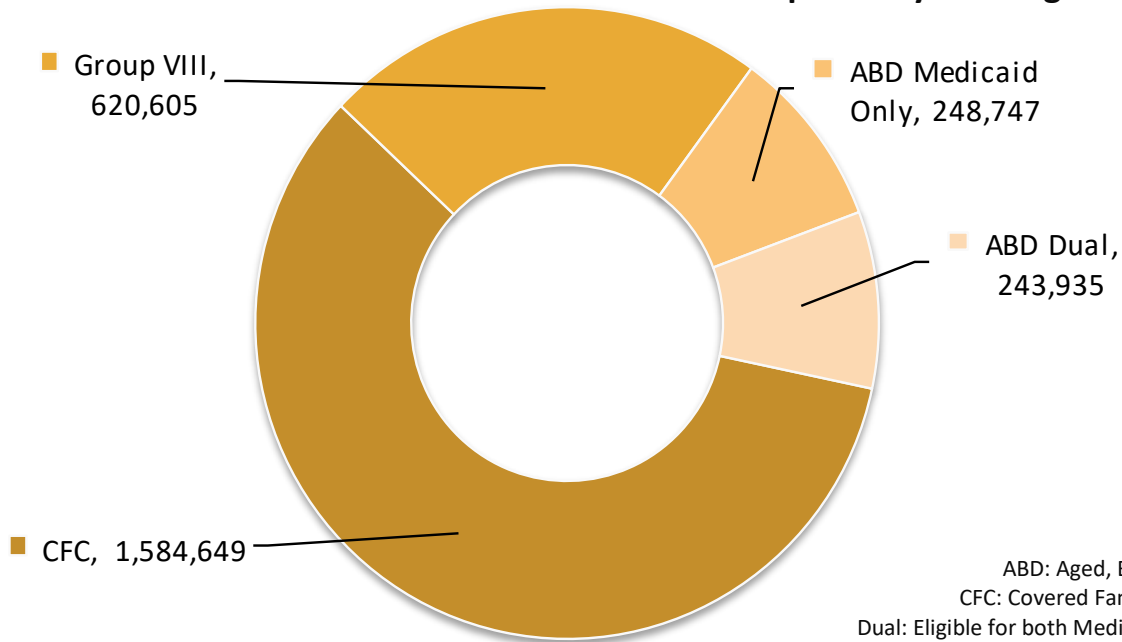


Medicaid Caseload at a Glance

Approximately one out of four Ohioans were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2020

- ◆ 2.83 million (24.2%) of Ohio's 11.69 million residents were enrolled in Medicaid in FY 2020.
- ◆ 2.70 million (95.3%) of Medicaid enrollees received full benefits; 133,000 (4.7%) received limited or Medicare premium or copayment assistance benefits.
- ◆ Of the 2.70 million enrollees who received full benefits, 2.45 million (90.8%) were served by managed care (MC) plans, and 249,000 (9.2%) were served by fee-for-service (FFS) care.

Service Methods for CFC

- ◆ 97.2% of enrollees received managed care
- ◆ 2.8% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for Group VIII

- ◆ 93.3% of enrollees received managed care
- ◆ 6.7% of enrollees received FFS care

Service Methods for ABD Medicaid Only and ABD Dual

- ◆ 81.7% of Medicaid Only enrollees received managed care, and 18.3% of Medicaid Only enrollees received FFS care
- ◆ 50.4% of Dual enrollees received managed care, and 49.6% of Dual enrollees received FFS care
