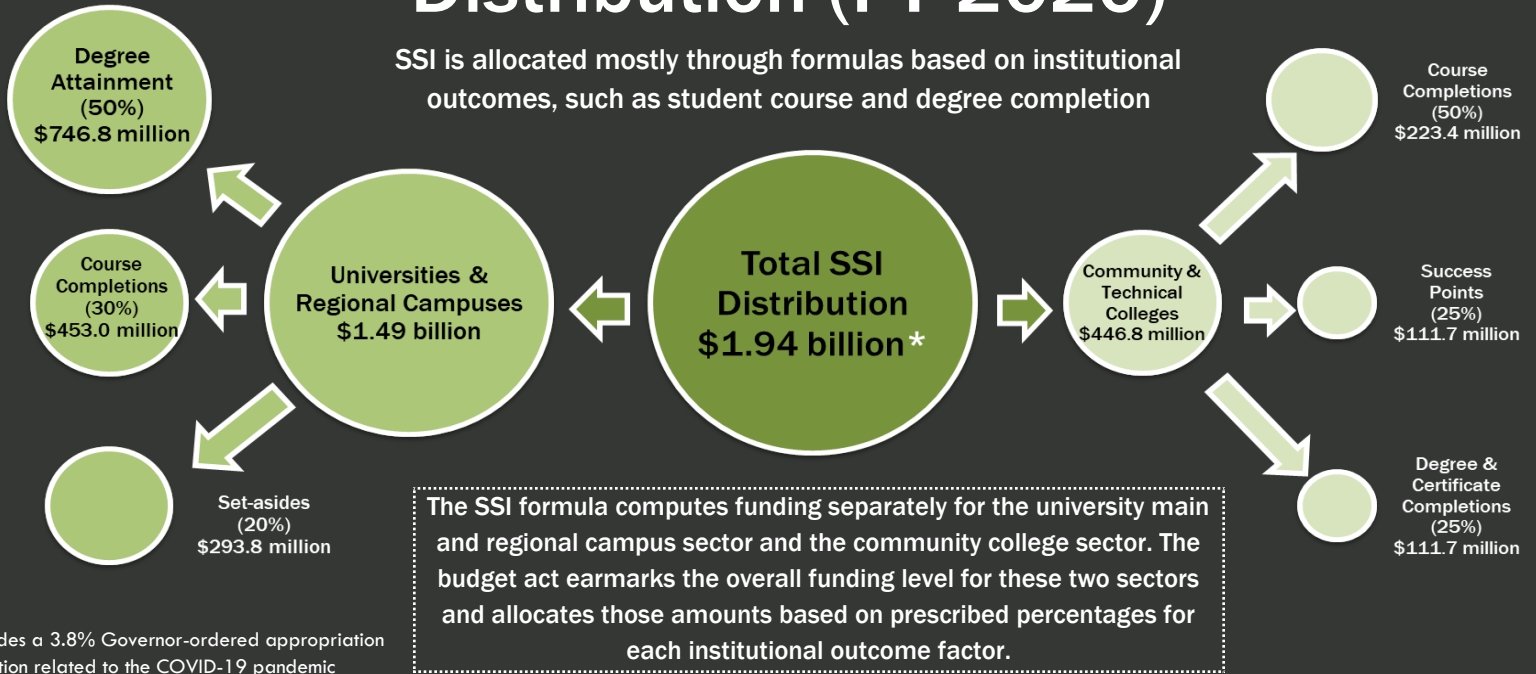


State Share of Instruction

- ★ Serves as Ohio's primary financial support to public higher education
- ★ Provides unrestricted operating subsidies to Ohio's 61 public colleges and universities, funding a portion of the operating costs of serving approximately 323,000 full-time equivalent (FTE) students

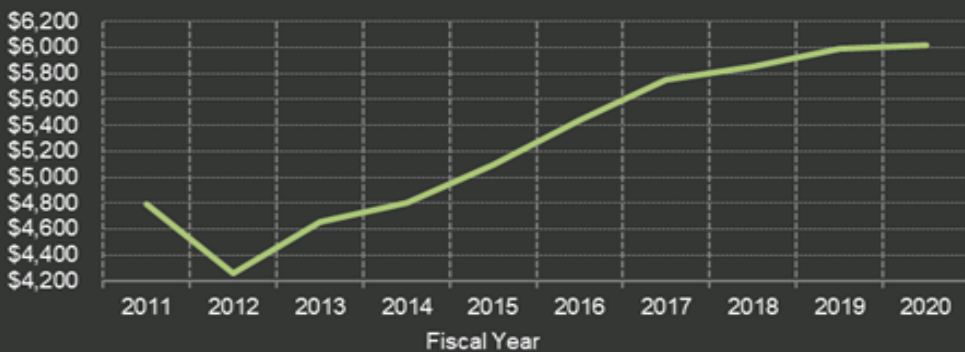
Distribution (FY 2020)

SSI is allocated mostly through formulas based on institutional outcomes, such as student course and degree completion



★ On a per-student basis, SSI reached a decade high of **\$6,016** in FY 2020

From FY 2012 to FY 2020:

Enrollment

SSI per student increased 41.1% since FY 2012 due to declining enrollment and increased appropriations

Total subsidy-eligible FTEs at public colleges and universities have decreased every year since FY 2012, led by two-year campuses
